The Maidstone Hub are identifying the most vulnerable through a triage system, and signposting to the nearest volunteer group to provide support and help. The requests for help we now need to respond to are focused around three main areas:

- ✚ Offering help with emergency food parcels, for those that are self-isolating.
- ✚ Arranging help to have prescriptions delivered.
- ✚ Supporting those that are isolated with keep in touch telephone calls.

Responses are focused around the following:-

- ✚ Food and care packages (food boxes, hot meals and household and hygiene items)
- ✚ Collection and delivery of medicines (prescriptions)
- ✚ Providing social contact (ringing those who are isolated) I am working with Hina Nagar, our COVID-19 Community Liaison lead, to establish where this type of help is available across Maidstone borough. I am in the process of contacting all those who have been in touch offering help and support so that we can map these resources which will enable us all to work in a joined-up way
